






Comparing Unemployment and Population Change Reveals Region Patterns @esri





Story Maps are a great way to combine your maps with narrative text, images, and multimedia content to create compelling, user-friendly web apps. In these lessons, you'll author Story Maps using interactive builders to create a Story Map Tour, a Story Map Cascade, and a Story Map Journal.

Setup | Configuration | Editing

- Different story map styles for different purposes (cruise the <u>overview</u> tab on apps page)
- Some apps are just for viewing (simple map viewer)
 Others are for interactive analysis (image comparisons)
- Learning process in one story map doesn't necessarily translate to another story map
- Some story maps are more labor intensive than others
- Have as much of the content completed up front to avoid the need for editing within Story Map

Functionality

- Story maps can be imbedded in other story maps
 - A tabbed story map might have other story maps (map viewer, Story Map Tour etc.) within each tab
 - Can embed the Tabs layout in one of Journal sections
- Web App Builder can add tools (aka "widgets") to a map viewer to perform various tasks with the data in the map
