Peter Zaykoski joined the Commission's Water Resources Protection staff in 2018. He serves as the Lowell Project Manager for NEIWPCC's work with the Hudson River Estuary Reserve and the Hudson River National Estuarine Research Reserve. These programs conduct research, provide educational opportunities, and conduct restoration and stewardship activities in the Lower Hudson River and its watershed.



Zaykoski also manages NEIWPCC's Quality Management Program. In that capacity, he reviews quality assurance project plans, oversees QA training, and coordinates QA-related activities with the EPA and other state and federal agencies on behalf of NEIWPCC.

Before joining the Commission staff, Zaykoski provided support to World Education, Inc. ensuring federal audit readiness and coordinating with field teams in Uganda to develop and implement best practices. He has also worked as a project manager for SeaPlan, developing policy guidance and geographic data to support regional and state ocean planning initiatives. He has worked as a research technician at the Duke University Marine Lab, and as a junior coastal advocate for the North Carolina Coastal Federation.
