



First-Time RENEWAL Application for Soil Evaluator (SE)

Updated 23-April-2020

Soil Evaluators who perform evaluations pursuant to 310 CMR 15.101 through 15.106 shall be required to submit an application for renewal. Title 5, 310 CMR 15.000, requires that approvals be renewed on a three (3) year cycle. This renewal process also applies to Soil Evaluators who are Massachusetts Professional Engineers, Registered Sanitarians, or Massachusetts Certified Health Officers as well. Approved Soil Evaluators shall apply for renewal at least 90 days prior to the expiration date of the 3 years following their initial approval date.

Payment in the amount of **\$100.00** (or \$75 if you are a *municipal employee* and a Board of Health Inspector, Agent or Director – *proof is required*), payable to **NEIWPCC**, must accompany this application. If using credit card, Visa, MasterCard and Discover (No AmEx) are accepted. **DO NOT SEND CASH**. *Renewals submitted after the approval expiration date will need to include an additional late fee of \$30.*
