As an environmental analyst for the Water Resource Protection Division, Lynn serves as project manager for the New York Source Water Assessment and Protection Program, the annual Nonpoint Source conference, and supervises Lake Champlain Basin Program (LCBP) NY-based staff. She also organizes the Source Water Protection, Emerging Contaminant, and Nonpoint Source Pollution workgroups, and assists with other program activities and grants related to source water protection.



Lynn is the co-founder and co-president of the North American Youth Parliament for Water, a chapter of the World Youth Parliament for Water, where she develops, designs, and manages transcontinental programs and external institutional partnerships to advance water access equity and advocacy goals in North America. She collaboratively contributed to an analysis of freshwater treaties, laws, and management institutions as a research assistant to the Transboundary Freshwater Dispute Database program at Oregon State University. Lynn also worked with EcoPeace Middle East in 2020 where she designed educational materials on Blue Peace for the Jordan River Basin, and worked with Raritan Headwaters Association in 2019 to develop communication platforms for their stream monitoring station data mapping program.
