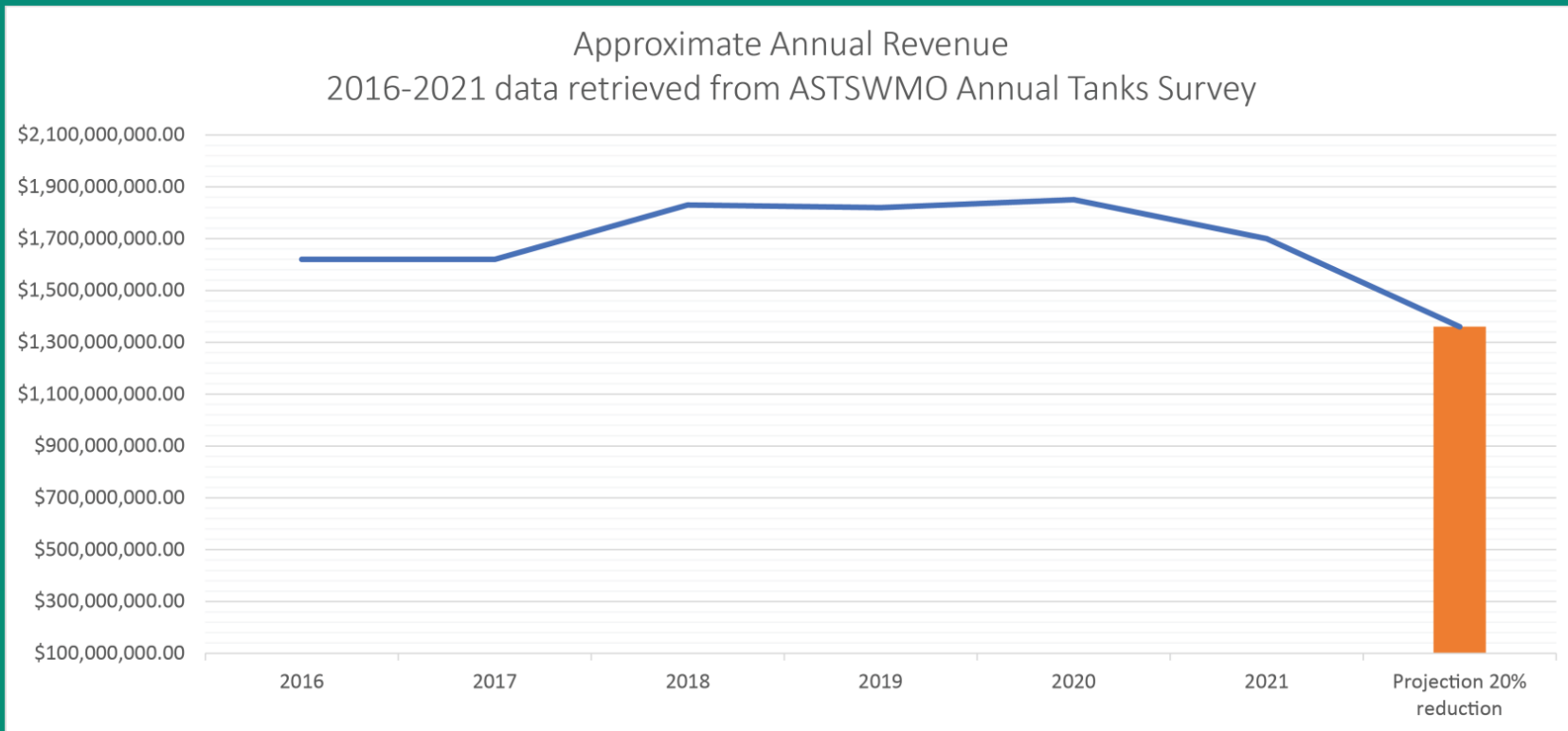

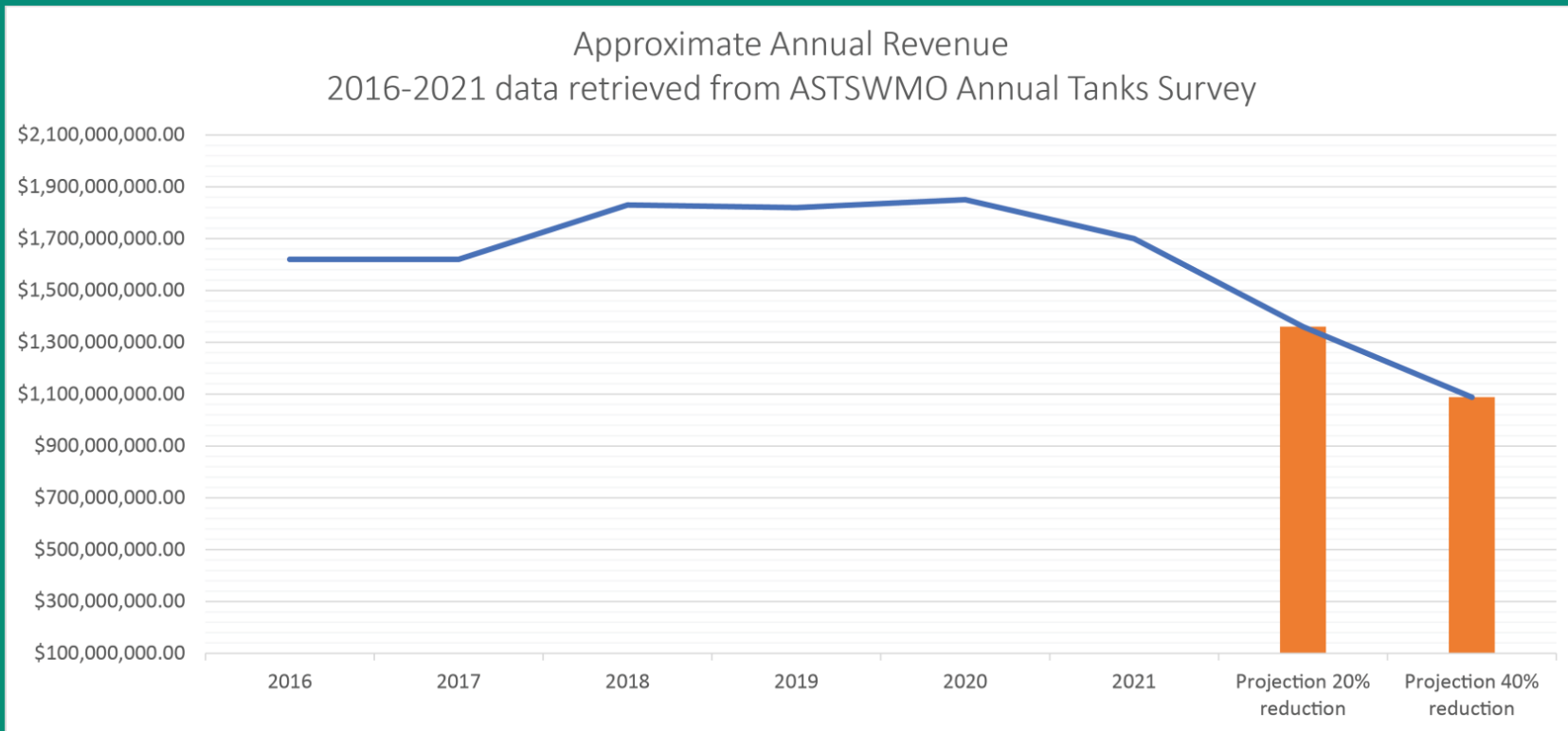

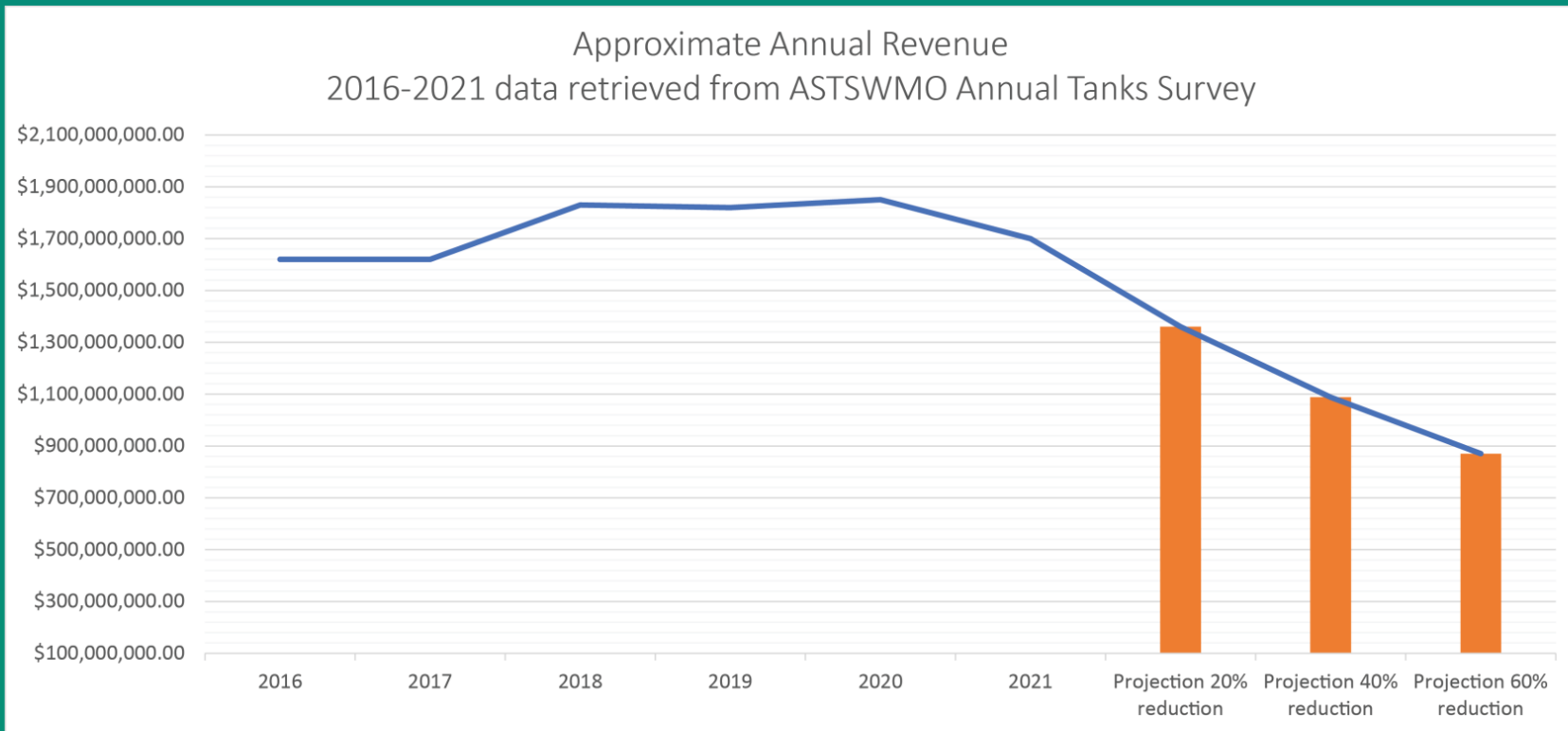

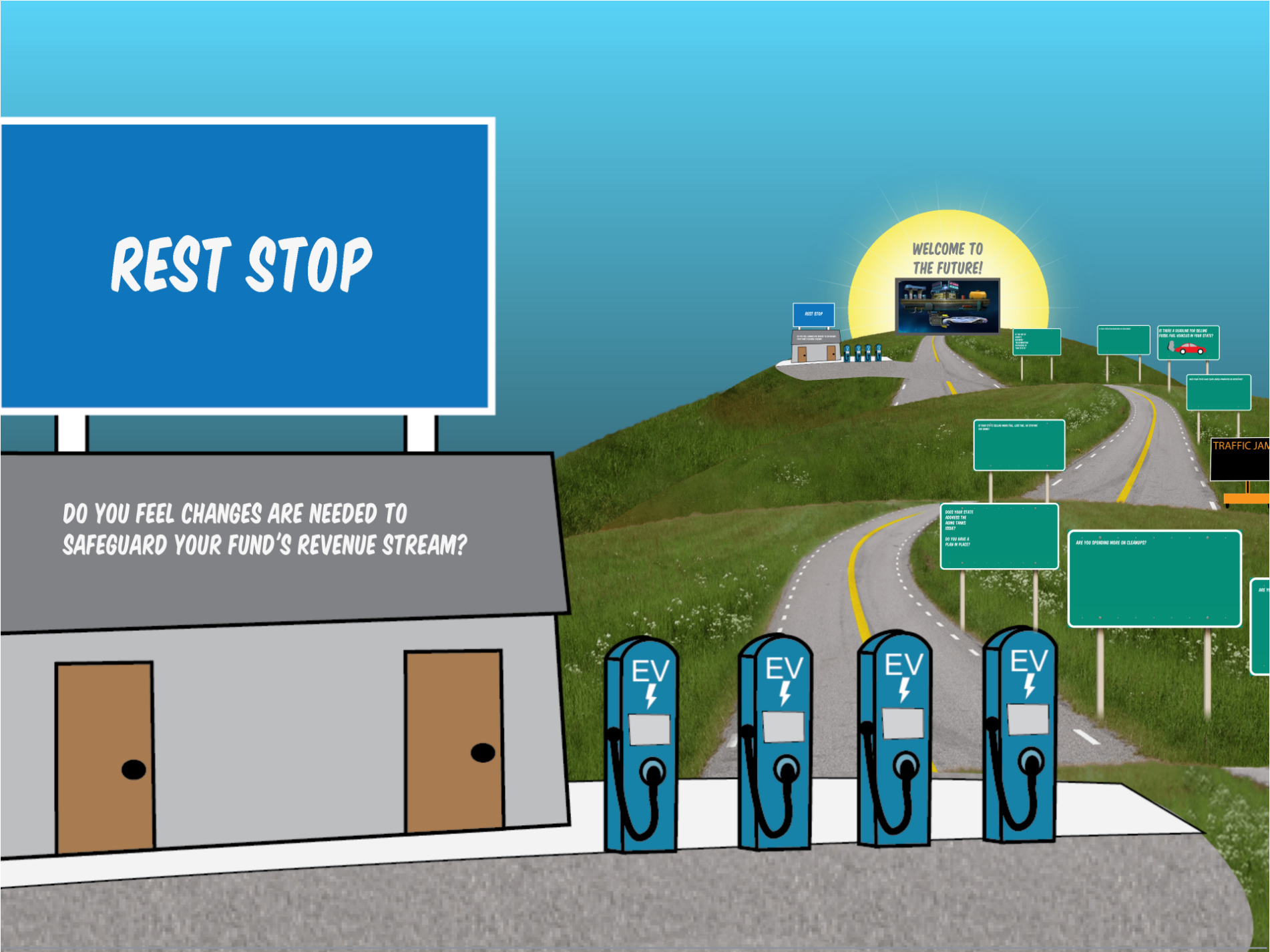

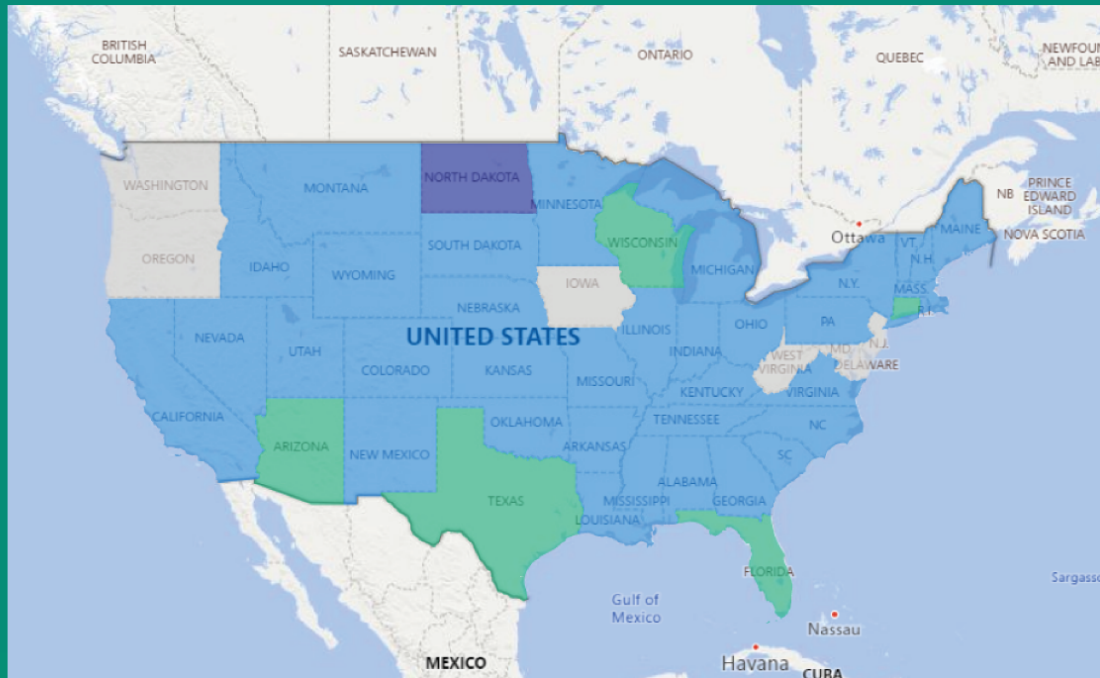

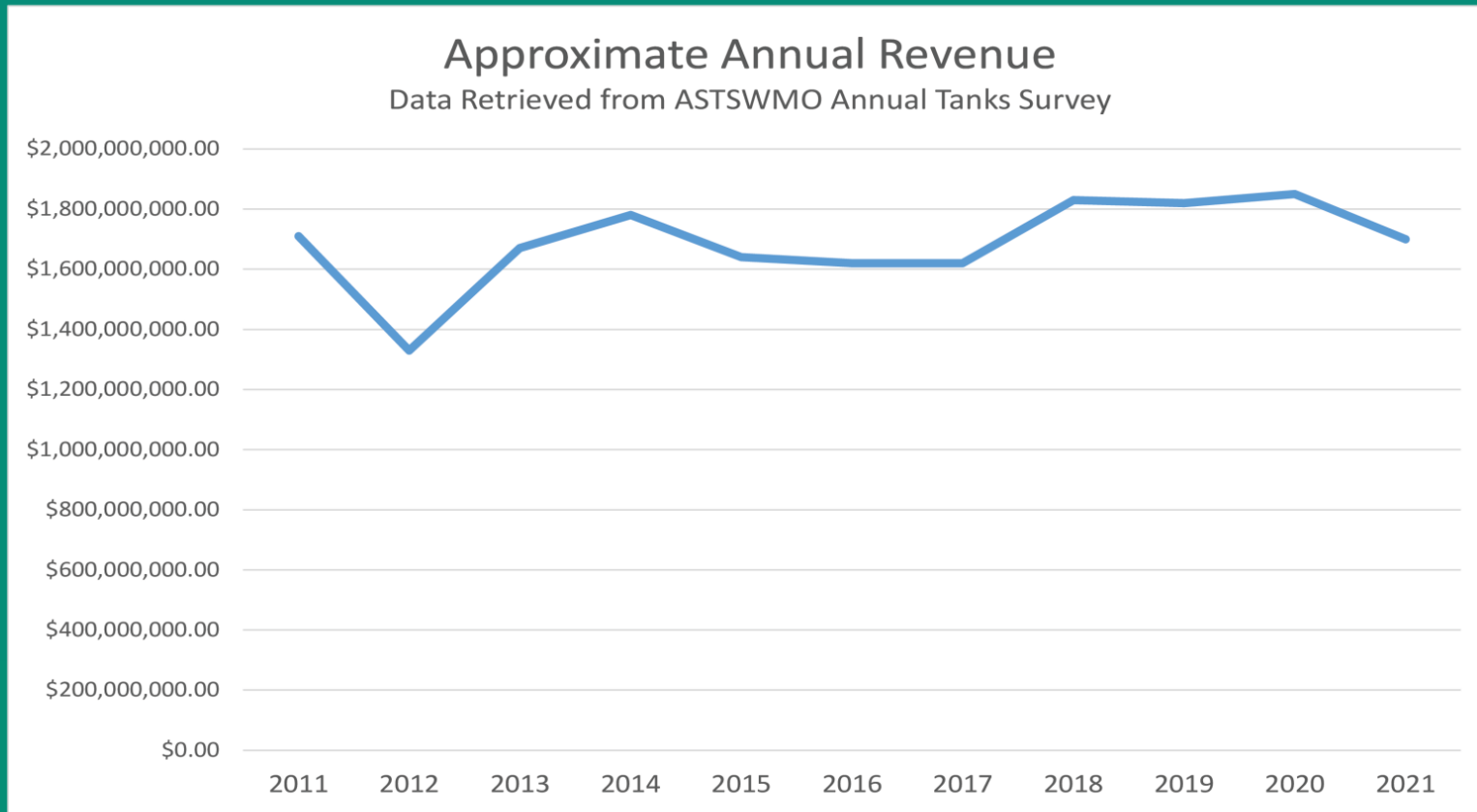


- Active Fund with Petroleum Use-Based Funding Pays for New and Past Releases (35 states)
- Active Fund Relies on Per-Tank Fee rather than Petroleum Use-Based Funding (1 state)
- Phased Out Fund Pays for Releases Prior to Phase Out (5 states)
- No EPA Approved State Fund (9 states and DC)

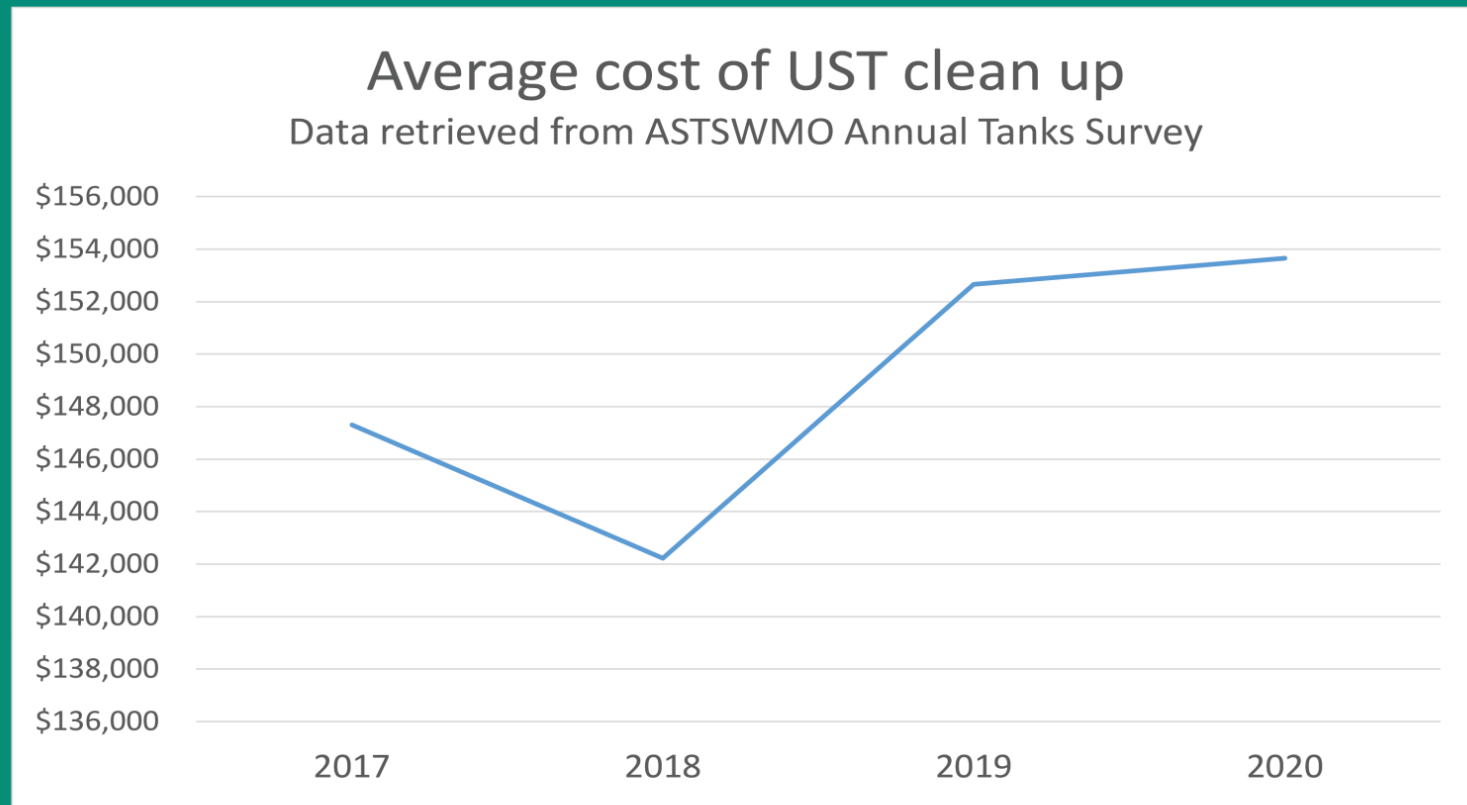

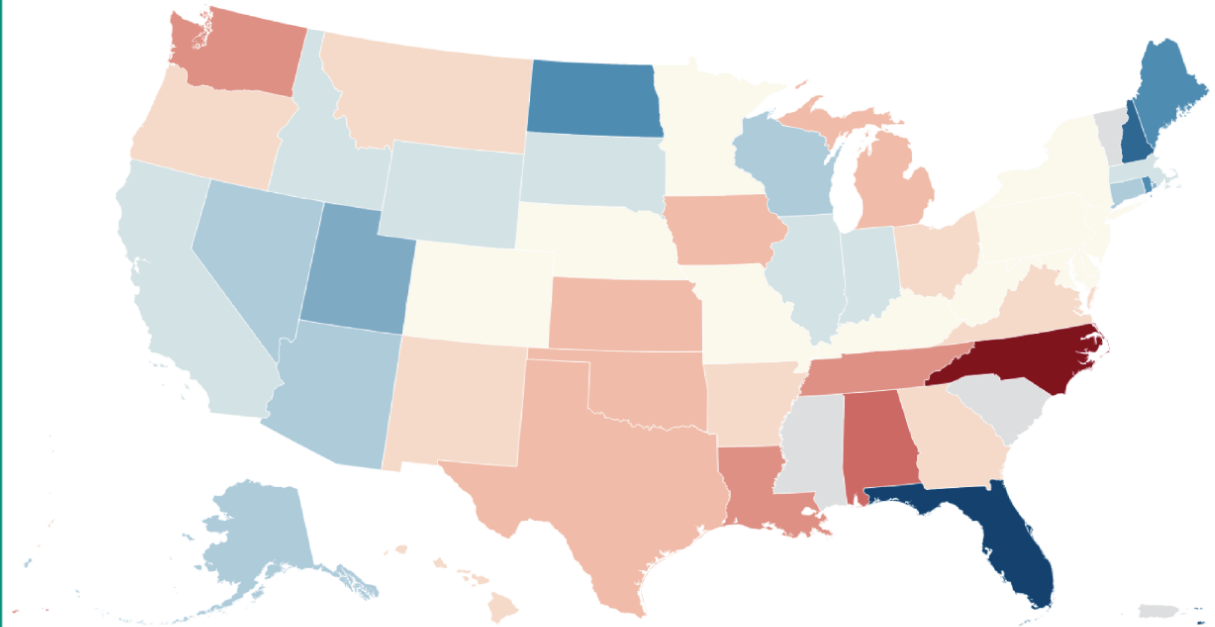

Average Age of UST (2020)

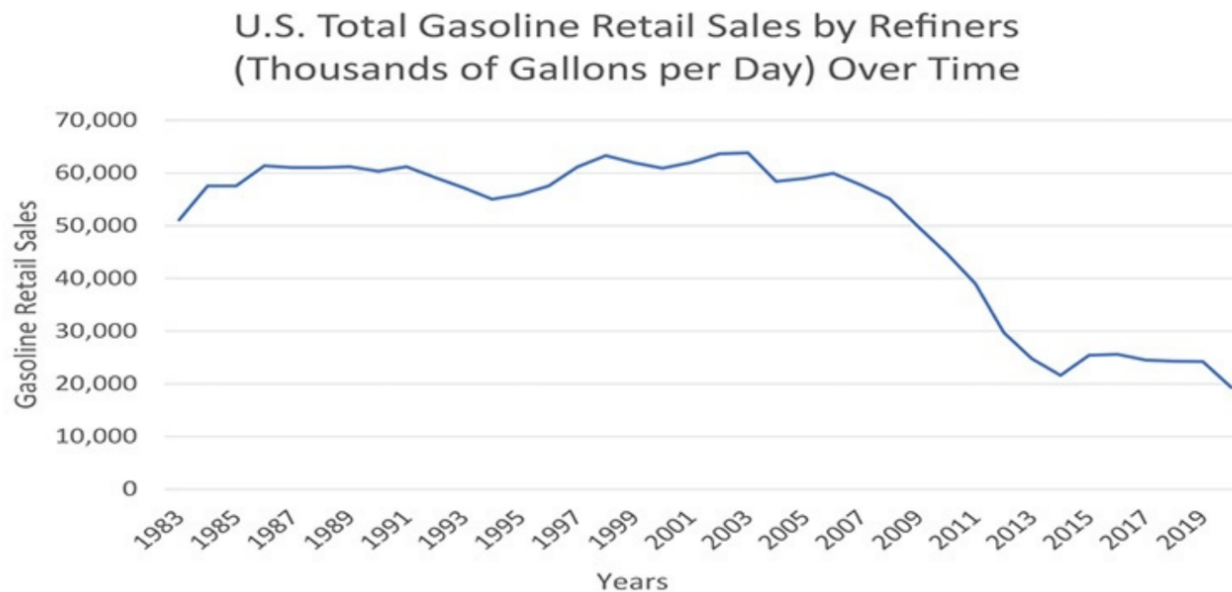
Average Age of USTs from EPA's USTFinder as of 2020. The average age of USTs for the United States is 26 years.

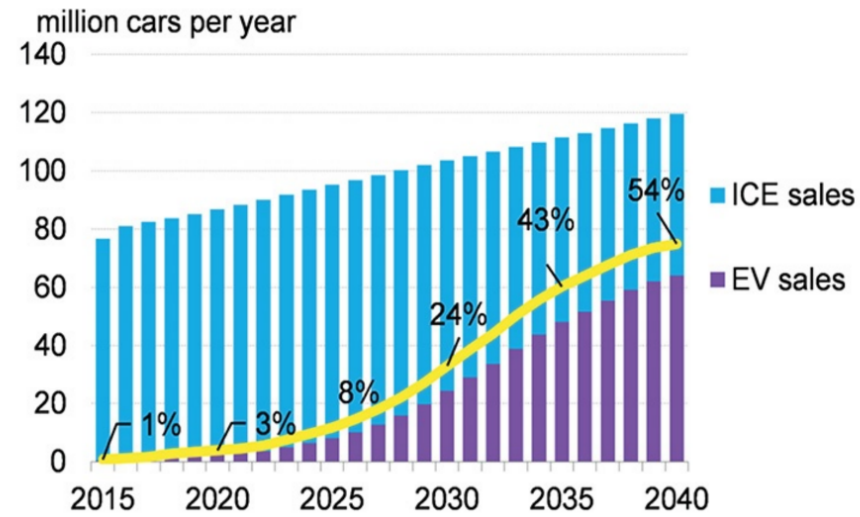

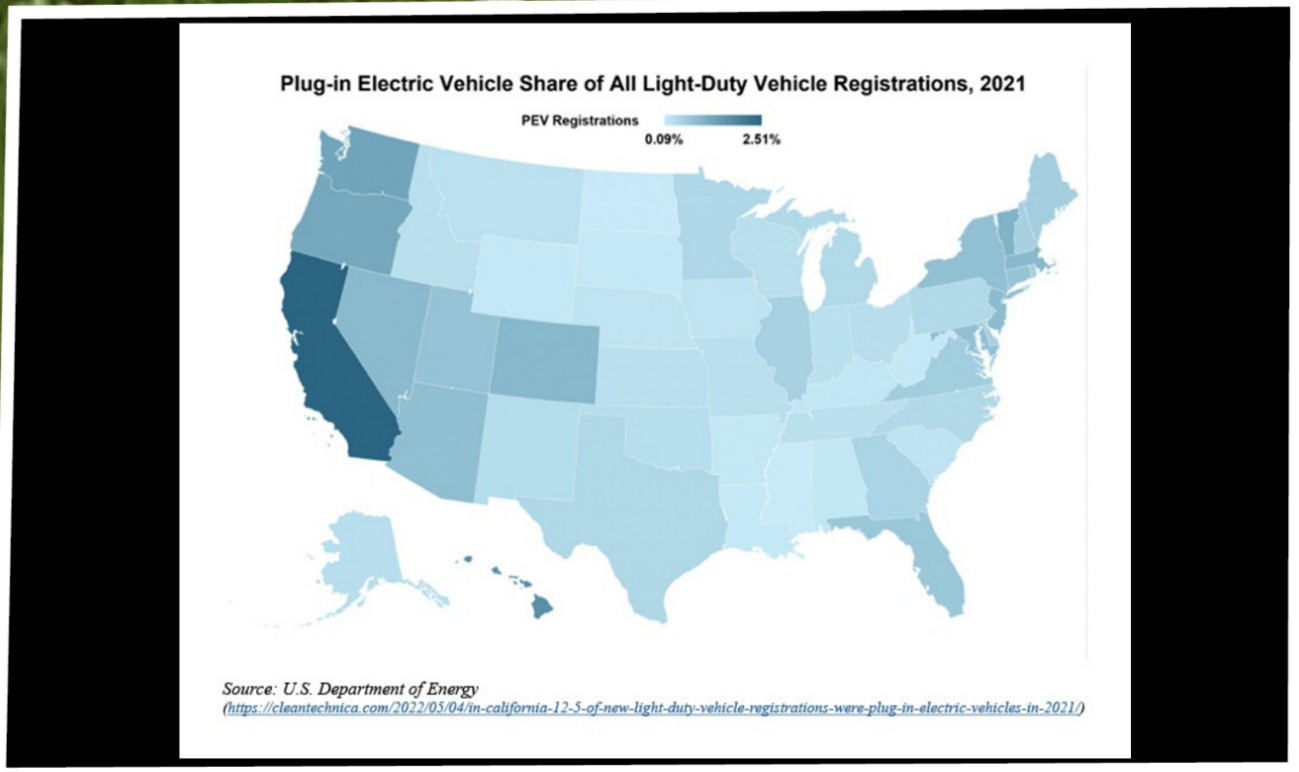

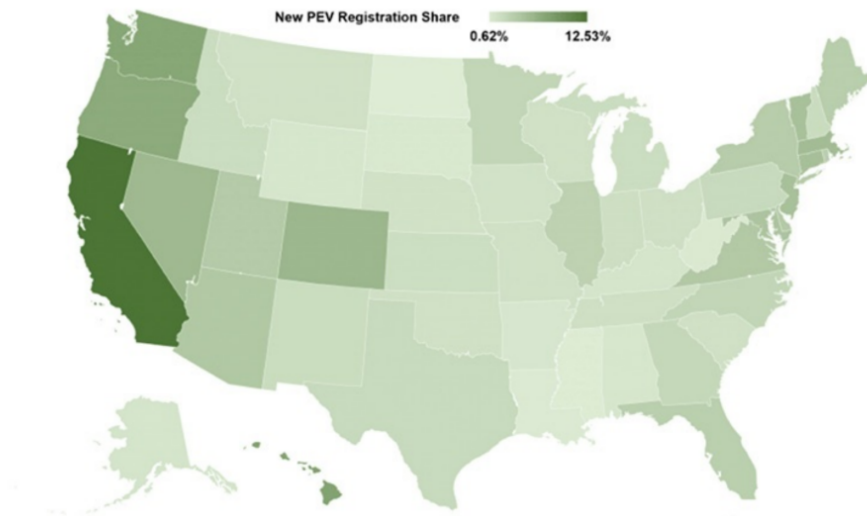
Annual Global Light-Duty Vehicle Sales



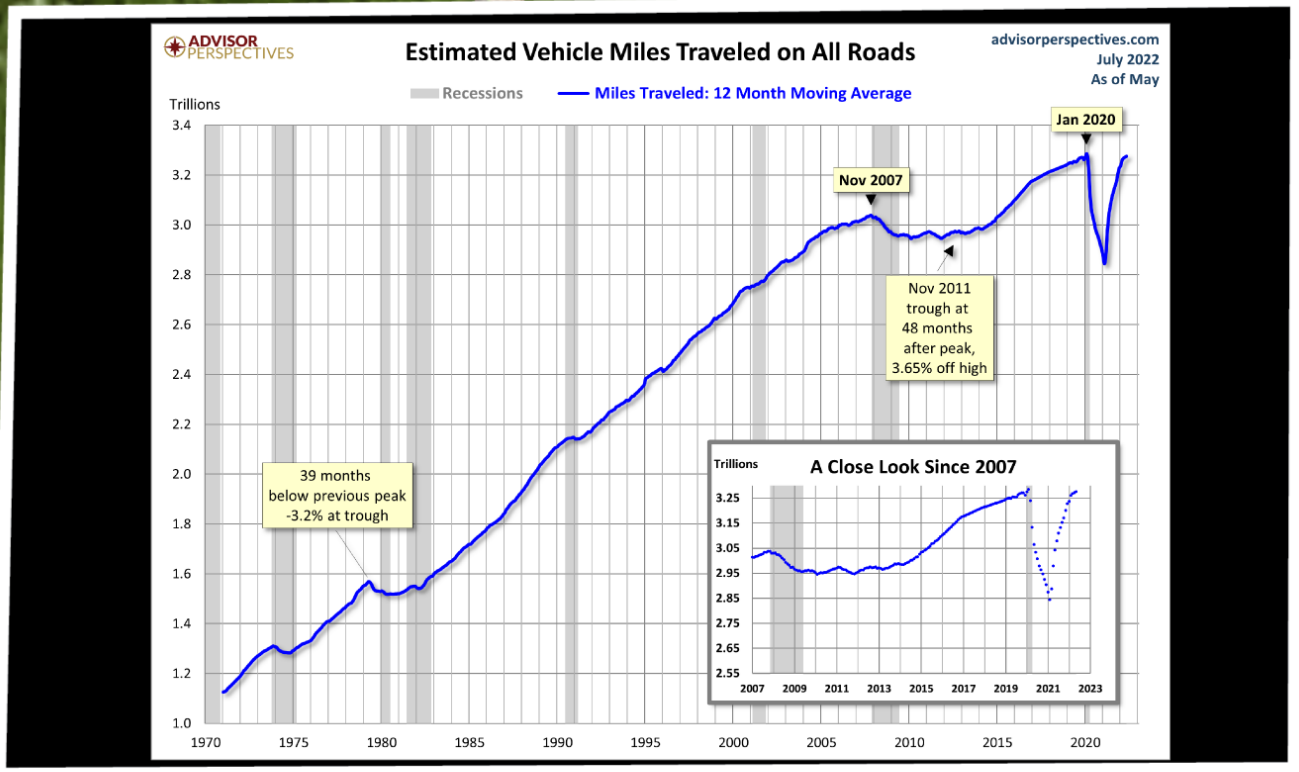

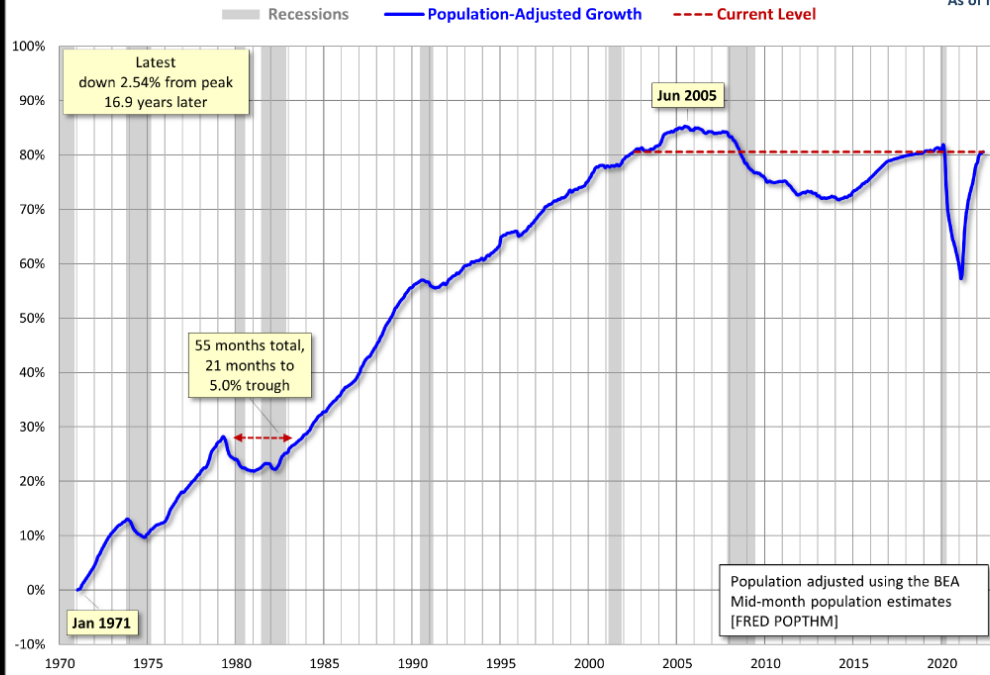
New Plug-in Electric Vehicle Share of New Light-Duty Vehicle Registrations, 2021

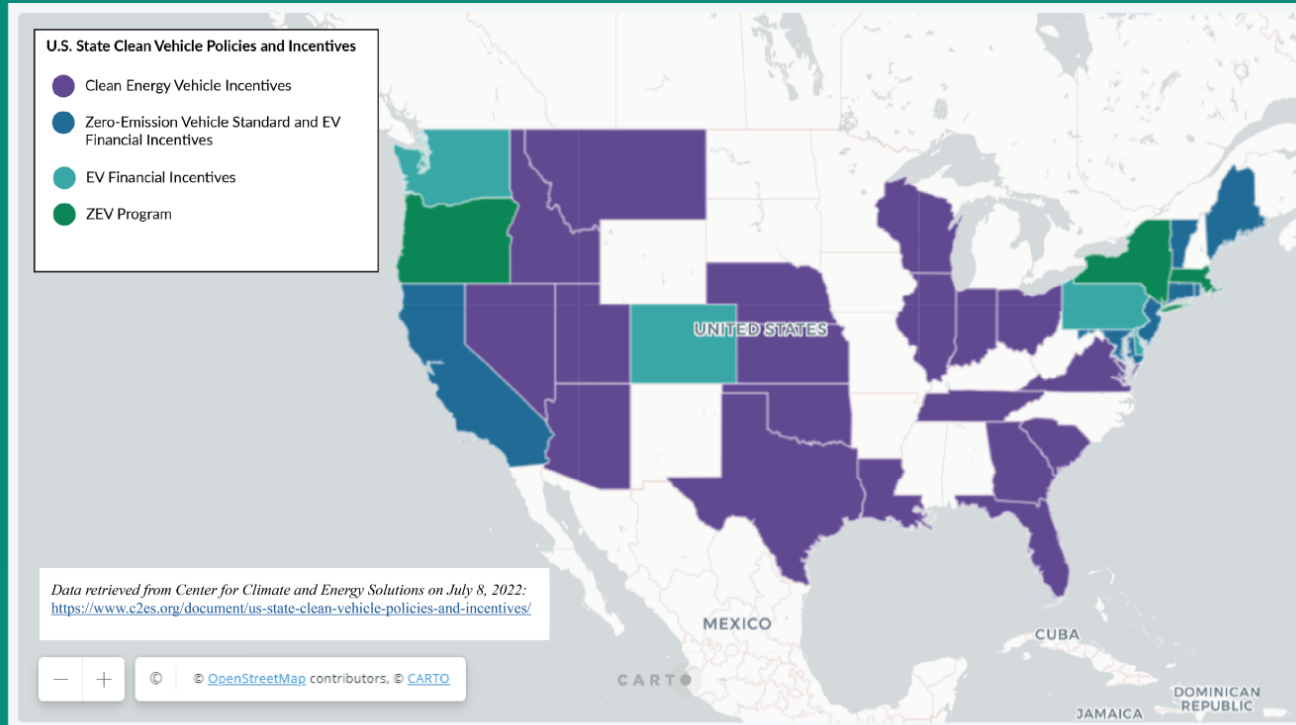


Estimated Vehicle Miles Traveled on All Roads

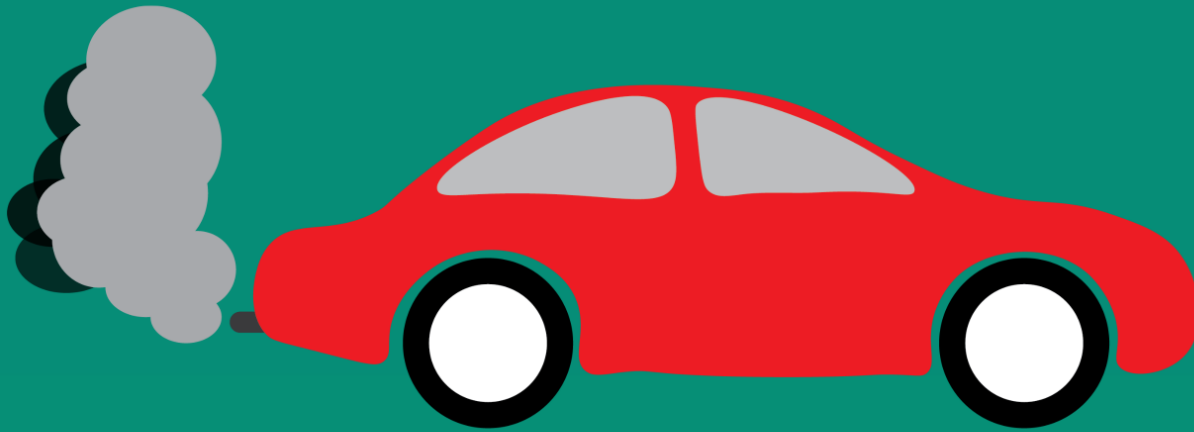

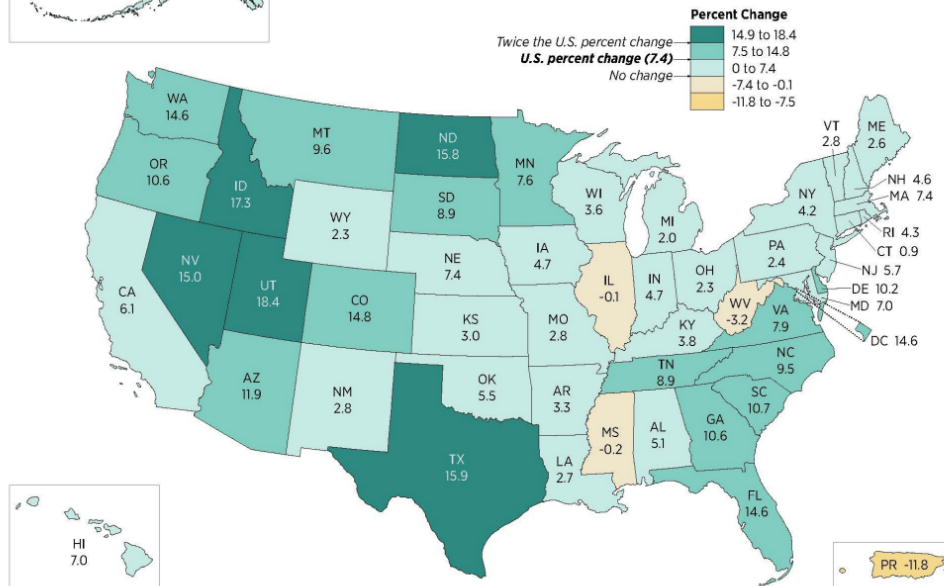

Percent Change in Resident Population for the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico: 2010 to 2020



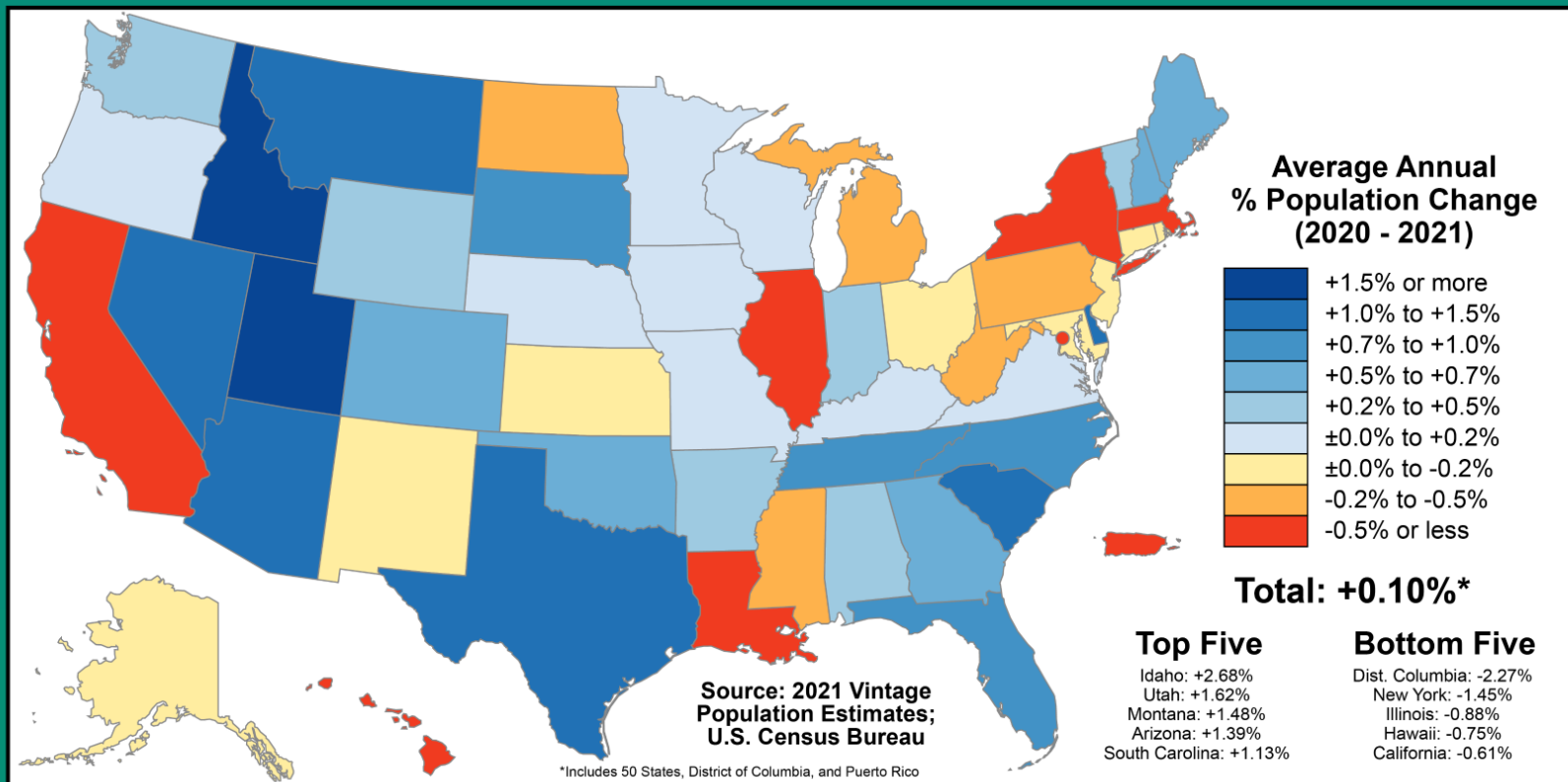

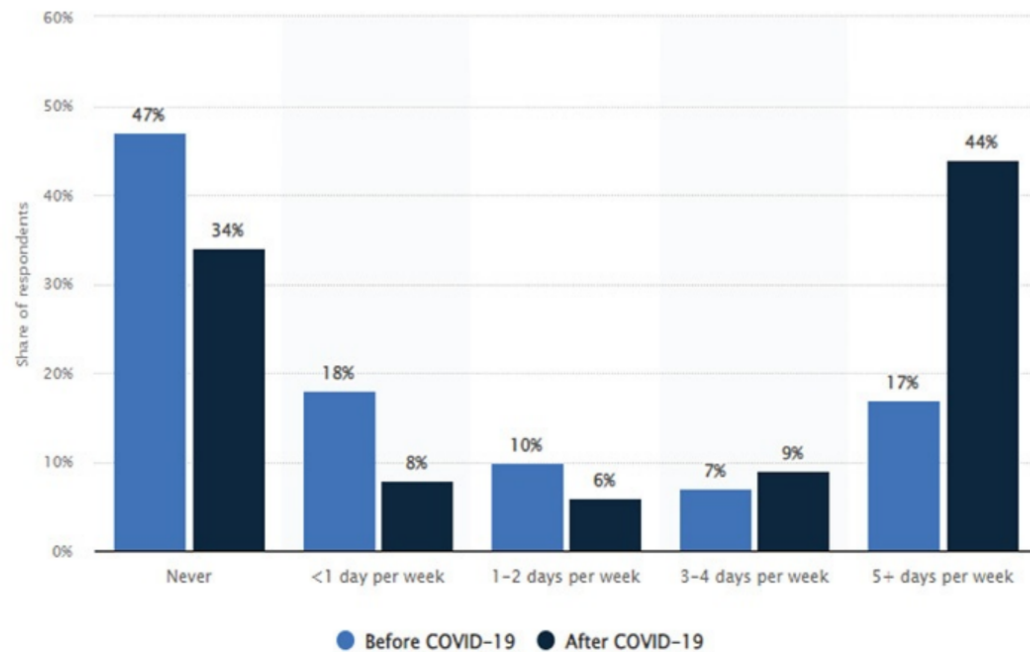

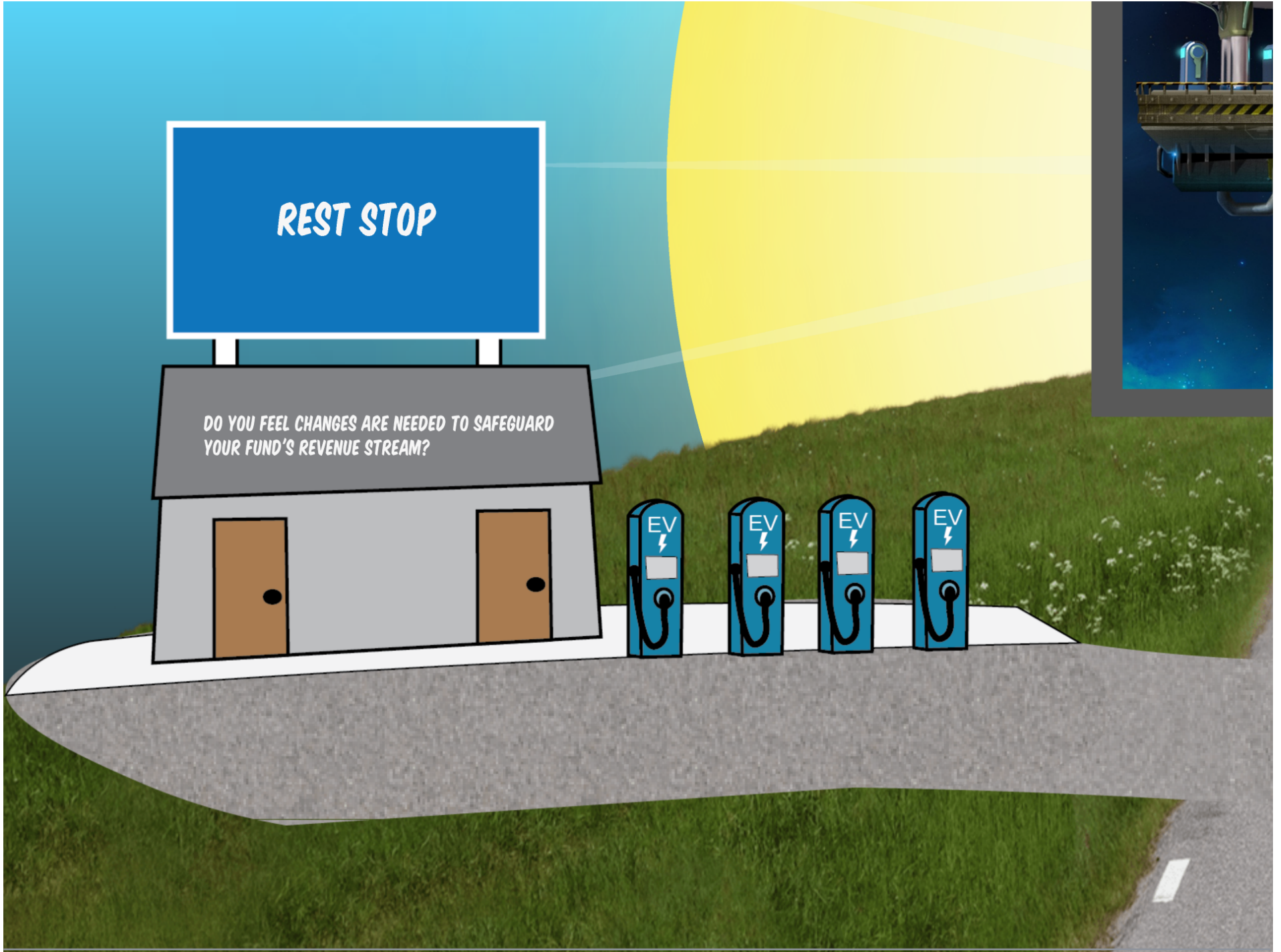
