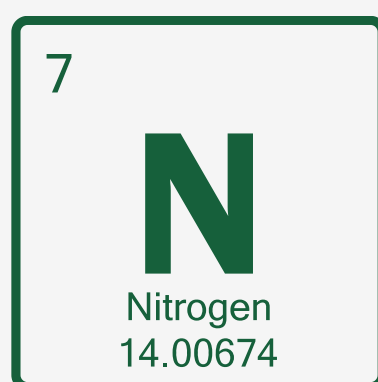


### \$1.912 BILLION

### 1,334

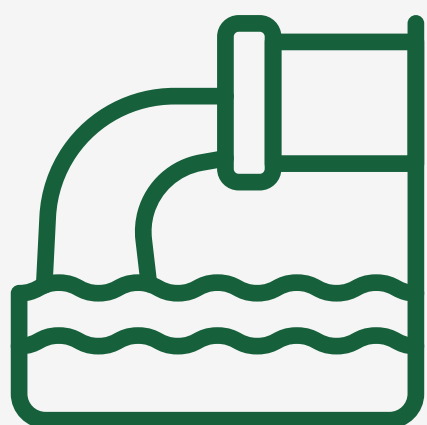


homes connected to public sewer.

septic systems upgraded with the best available technology for nutrient removal.

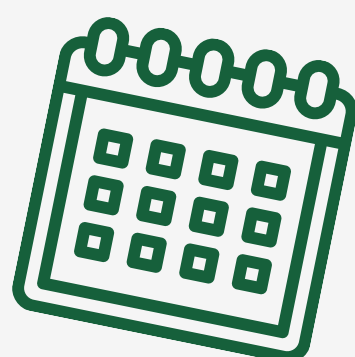


### 67
