COURSES QUALIFYING FOR DEP RECERTIFICATION/REINSTATEMENT - CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS

Maine law requires a contractor filling or disturbing soil in the municipal shoreland zone have a DEP-certified individual responsible for erosion and sediment controls on-site each day until the site is permanently stable. Individuals must complete approved Continuing Education Hours to maintain certification. There is a 6-month grace period for recertification from the expiration date.
