Beth serves as the project manager for the regional Water Quality Standards (WQS), tracking and accounting, and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) workgroups, and as the NEIWPCC project manager for the Long Island Nitrogen Action Plan (LINAP). In addition, she coordinates and manages the national 303(d)/TMDL webinar series and success stories projects, and a variety of other projects related to water science, policy, and outreach.



Beth joined NEIWPCC in August 2024 after a dedicated career with the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services. As Volunteer River Assessment Program coordinator, Beth organized and implemented a statewide volunteer river monitoring program, leading training as well as data collection, management, and analysis. Then, as an environmentalist, she coordinated National Environmental Policy Act environmental assessments for construction projects, minimizing social and environmental impacts and ensuring compliance with crosscutting regulations. Most recently, she served as administrator of the Grants Management Section focusing on the New Hampshire Clean Water State Revolving Fund, providing funding and assistance for water pollution control infrastructure projects. In this role, she secured funding in excess of \$20 million annually for sustainable water infrastructure projects and managed over \$25 million annually in loan repayments, while broadening funding allocations and developing effective implementation strategies for stakeholders.
