

WHAT TO BRING

□ Agenda and Meeting Materials: To reduce the environmental impact of the NAB Conference, all materials will be available online at www.neiwpcc.org/nabconference. Printed copies will not be provided at the registration desk. Large agenda posters and scannable QR codes will be available for easy access via cellphones or tablets. Hotel Wi-Fi credentials will be provided at registration and in session rooms.

PREPARING FOR YOUR PRESENTATION

- **Print Your Poster:** Ensure your poster is printed before the conference. There are no specific size requirements, but posters must be freestanding and compatible with an easel. Posters cannot be hung or attached to walls.
- Prepare a Support Surface:
 - o If your poster requires support, bring a frame, foam core poster board, or a similar surface.
 - A limited number of foam core boards will be available at the registration desk if needed.
 - Set Up Your Poster:
 - Easels will be provided throughout the Summit Ballroom Foyer, interspersed with exhibitor tables.
 - Set up your poster upon arrival. Your poster may remain displayed for the duration of the conference.
 - Supplies such as binder clips, tape, and pushpins will be available at the registration desk.
- Poster Design & Accessibility Considerations: Design your poster with readability in mind—use large, clear fonts and high-contrast colors. Avoid relying solely on color by incorporating labels or patterns. Provide verbal explanations for complex visuals to accommodate attendees with visual impairments.
- Special Requests: Please notify us promptly of any specific needs or requests, and we will do our best to accommodate

- **Poster Session Timing:** The poster session begins at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 5, immediately following the last oral presentation. Appetizers and a cash bar will be available during the session.
