Title 5 Renewal Fact Sheet

Certification as an approved Title 5 System Inspector (SI) or Soil Evaluator (SE) is valid for **three years**. Renewal requirements are based on your **initial approval date**.

- First Renewal (3 years after initial approval): No Training Contact Hours (TCHs) are required.
- Subsequent Renewals (6, 9, 12 years, etc. after initial approval): You must submit proof of 10 approved TCHs earned within the previous three years.

PLEASE NOTE: Individuals who wish to maintain their Title 5 approval but are **not currently active in the field** may request to switch to **INACTIVE status**.

• INACTIVE status holders are not required to obtain Training Contact Hours (TCHs); however, they must still submit a completed renewal form and pay the \$100 renewal fee every three years.

• While in INACTIVE status, individuals are **not permitted** to perform **Title 5 system inspections** or **soil evaluations**. To return to **ACTIVE status**, individuals must:

- 1. Submit proof of having completed 10 approved TCHs within the same calendar year,
- 2. Complete a Change of Status form, and
- 3. Pay a **\$25 administrative fee**.
