Qualifications for Eligibility

Board of Health Member or Agent

Submit letter from Town Clerk or Board of Health Director establishing 1 year of experience.

Engineer in Training (EIT)

Submit copy of certifying documentation and proof of concentration (civil, environmental or sanitary)

Licensed Home Inspector or Associate Home Inspector Submit copy of Mass. state registration card.

Septage Hauler

Submit copy of license.

System Installer or Pumper

Submit copy of town or city permit.

Others

Submit letter from employer verifying experience of at least one year in septic system inspections or design.

Pre-Qualified - Class/Exam Not Required

- Mass. Registered Professional Engineer (civil, sanitary or environmental engineering)
- Mass. Certified Health Officer
- Mass. Registered Sanitarian

Pre-qualified applicants are not required to take the training or the exam. A \$100 fee and pre-approval application can be submitted to NEIWPCC.

Massachusetts Title 5 System Inspector Eligibility Form

System Inspectors who perform inspections pursuant to 310 CMR 15.301 shall be: (a) Massachusetts Registered Professional Engineers with a concentration in civil, sanitary or environmental engineering; Massachusetts Registered Sanitarians; or Certified Health Officers; or (b) Board of Health members or agents, Engineers in Training (EIT certified) with a concentration in civil, sanitary, or environmental engineering, professional home inspectors, licensed septage haulers, disposal system installers, or other individuals with a minimum of one year of demonstrated experience in septic system inspection, who have attended training provided or authorized by the Department; and who have passed an examination prepared and administered by the Department or an agent authorized by the Department to qualify as an approved System Inspector pursuant to 310 CMR 15.34-(2).

Please read all questions carefully and answer fully. Application must be filled out completely, where applicable, and proof of eligibility (see next page) must be attached. Eligible persons must take the SI class and pass the SI exam in order to become a MA Title 5 System Inspector (see next page).* Also note that this form should be completed and submitted at the same time as the certification course registration form.

Attach recent photo with face not less than one inch wide, or a copy of driver's license may be used. Please note this is a mandatory requirement.
